

# H5A Fisheye Camera Line Firmware Release Notes

# Version 4.66.0.26 – Released September 15, 2023

#### **New Features**

• "No Smart Analytics" mode has been renamed to "No Video Analytics"

### **Issues Fixed**

- Resolves internal manufacturing issues
- Resolves an issue that can potentially cause incorrect URL redirections

## Version 4.60.0.30 – Released July 10, 2023

#### **Issues Fixed**

• Resolves a critical issue with FW version 4.60.0.24 where the camera goes into a reboot loop when using Dewarp Streaming Mode 180x2

# Customers on FW version 4.60.0.24 are recommended to upgrade to 4.60.0.30 as soon as possible.

# Version 4.60.0.24 – Released May 30, 2023

### **New Features**

- A new option titled "No Smart Analytics" is available through the WebUI that allows the disabling of Smart Analytics functions (basic analytics will not be disabled)
- ONVIF Profile M is now supported

#### **Issues Fixed**

- Resolves internal manufacturing issues
- Resolves an issue that could potentially cause issues when loading the WebUI on Mac-based Safari and Google Chrome browsers

# Version 4.44.0.14 fixes an issue present in version 4.44.0.12. Customers with the affected firmware versions are recommended to upgrade the firmware as soon as possible.

# Version 4.44.0.14 – Released November 8, 2022

#### **Issues Fixed**

- Fixes an issue on 4.44.0.12 where a temporary network disruption to ACC or the NTP service may result in cameras not streaming to ACC, even when the network connection is restored
- Fixes an issue that can cause the camera not to adjust to Daylight Savings Time correctly when set to the IST/IDT time zone

## Version 4.44.0.12 – Released Oct 17, 2022 (not recommended for use)

## **New Features**

• Adds support for Profile M (ONVIF Compliant Metadata will need to be enabled from the Analytics tab within WebUI Setup)

#### **Issues Fixed**

- Fixes an issue that could potentially cause the camera to fail to connect to ACC if the NTP server is unreachable
- Fixes an issue that could potentially cause the Pixel Motion Detection settings to be unchangeable in ACC 7.14.14.4 (for 12.0W-H5A-FE-DO1-IR camera only)

## Version 4.18.0.122 – Released Apr 12, 2022

#### **Issues Fixed**

• Improvements to the logging of camera events.

## Version 4.18.0.68 – Released Aug 17, 2021

#### **Issues Fixed**

• Fixed an issue which results in camera stream restarting intermittently when smartcodec is enabled.

## Version 4.18.0.46 – Released Jul 26, 2021

#### **New Features**

- Added support for cameras side dewarping of video streams. Dewarp streams can be accessed from the WebU, select the **General** tab and choose desired dewarping streaming option in the **Mode** dropdown.
- Added option to disable the WebUI. This setting can be accessed by logging into the WebUI and selecting the **Disable WebUI** tab.

## Version 4.15.0.26 – Released May 26, 2021

#### **New Features**

• This release enables Appearance Search and Facial Recognition as well as Teach By Example capabilities. Note: Appearance Search and Facial Recognition are only supported on Avigilon Control Center 7.14 or later

#### **Issues Fixed**

• Fixes an issue which could cause a slight oscillation in the image brightness to occur under certain conditions

## Version 4.15.0.24 – Released March 25, 2021

#### **Issues Fixed**

- Fixes an issue which could affect the IR illumination range of the camera
- Fixes an issue which could cause communication with the camera's SD cards to fail under certain conditions
- Improvement made to reduce occurrence of false-positive detections of people or vehicles

## Version 4.15.0.18 – Released March 1, 2021

• Initial firmware release for the H5A Fisheye Camera Line
