



PRIVATE SAFETY NETWORK INSTALLATION GUIDE

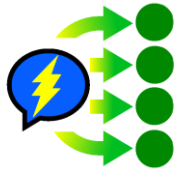
Introduction

Private Safety Network (PSN) gives organizations, schools, municipalities and the people in them the ability to communicate in real time. People can swiftly report what they see to onsite PSN user groups who can react immediately. Additionally they can communicate with responders, giving them complete, accurate, timely data directly from the site. Responders and administrators are able to send mass notifications, giving people fast, valuable information that can keep them safe.

PSN also uses data from Avigilon ACM, and includes it in the communications. Users' locations, room status, access control and security system events are all made available almost instantly to the people who need them. Building and room doors can also be locked or unlocked during an incident.

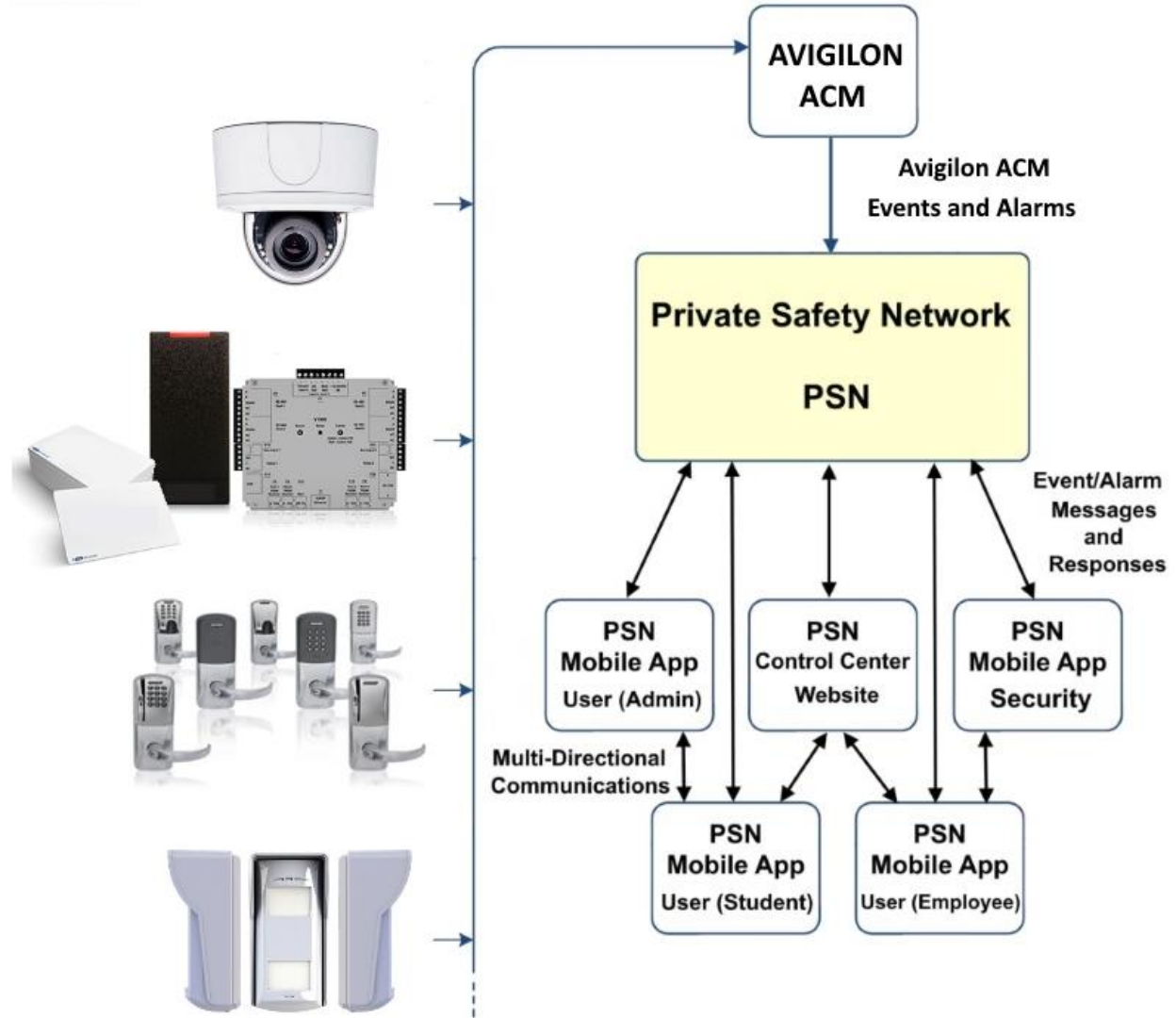
Integration Model Description

PSN uses an XML Collaboration to receive event data, and uses the REST API for listing, locking and unlocking doors.

REQUIREMENTS

License Requirements: PSN licensing is done on an annual subscription basis

PSN Product Requirements: PSN users use Apple or Android phones. The server hosting is provided by PSN.

Supported Avigilon Versions and Editions: ACM version 6.0.0.24



Any Other Required Hardware/Devices: None

Minimum System Requirements: N/A – PSN provides server hosting

INSTALLATION

PSN System Installation Requirements: PSN provides all server hardware and software installations.

Instructions for Installing the Integration: The XML collaboration must be setup, referencing the PSN IP address to be supplied.

CONFIGURATION

PSN System Configuration: The customer administrator of the PSN sets up users and user groups, cross references ACM devices (smart locks, card readers) to building and room locations, and configures groups to be messaged for event types.

Integration Configuration: The XML collaboration must be setup, referencing the PSN IP address to be supplied.

Avigilon Configuration, including Alarm Configuration (if applicable): As above.
